Program Notes

Darkness descends, the mood is tense - *THE SPOOK is near!* It wanders through the darkness enjoying the scary effect it has on those silly Human Beings.

Alas, as dawn approaches so does *The Spook's* arch enemy - light and happiness. It is forced into hiding, but only until tonight.

Rehearsal Notes

This piece is an ideal tool to introduce your ensemble to the differences between major and minor tonality.

In the "spooky" minor section, ensure the hypnotising accompaniment is light and precise. This then enables the melody and the "scary" effects to gain maximum effect.

Make use of the dynamic change at [13] and crescendos throughout this section to further build tension. The major key section at [29] will have audiences and orchestra tapping their toes, if the intended "happiness" is captured by the players.

The *D.C.* re-introduces *The Spook*. Practice this change back into the minor key and quickly establish the tense, spooky mood.

N.B. This arrangement is written to be played by full orchestra or can be played by string orchestra alone.

About the Composer

Brian West has been composing and arranging for young bands since developing an interest in this area of Music Education when studying at the Tasmanian Conservatorium of Music (Hobart) in the late 1970's.

Eleven years teaching music in high schools has enabled Brian to gain a first hand awareness of the needs of the young musician and the developing band.

Many of his original compositions for Young Band have now been published and his composition, *The Spook*, won the 1991 Brolga Music Composition Contest.

Brian is presently teaching Music and Audio Design at Rosny College in Hobart, Tasmania.
